NATURE OF WORK:

This position reports to the Disaster Program Manager under the Facilities Development and Management Office. The purpose of this position is to perform in-house design and construction management for FEMA projects.

ESSENTIAL TASKS:

- Performs construction management related tasks which includes:
 - o site assessment and site investigative works;
 - o permit coordination;
 - o daily monitoring of projects;
 - o review of plans and specifications;
 - o preparation and review of cost estimates and bid schedules;
 - o facilitating procurement services
- Prepares in-house architectural & engineering construction drawings and documents of all disciplines utilizing AutoCAD software. Prepares 3-dimensional renderings using SketchUp software or equivalent.
- Possesses thorough knowledge of IBC 2018 and all other applicable CNMI governing codes.
- Possesses thorough knowledge of building materials and construction methods.
- Excellent planning and organizational skills due to face-paced environment and high-volume work load are required.
- Assist with the coordination of regular meetings with PSS, third-party A&E firms, third-party construction contractors, regulatory agencies, external agencies, and other stakeholders involved, as required.

- Assist with the preparation of detailed reports, logs, worksheets, and other supporting documentation to ensure financial award provisions and conditions are in compliance and as required by FEMA, CDBG-DR, EDA and any other applicable agency.
- Assist with the response to RFI's (Request for Information) from the designer on record (DOR) or from PSS, as applicable, to be received by prospective contractors during the bidding process, or to be received by third-party construction contractors during the course of construction.
- Prepare close-out documentation for review by the Disaster Project Manager, including prefinal punch-list items and ensure performance of corrective work.
- Perform other tasks as required and attend to matters relating to the project management of all CNMI disaster projects.
- Must be able to travel.

FORTY (40) HOUR WORKWEEK:
