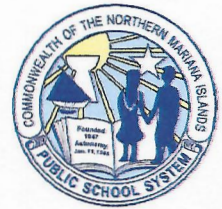

Proposals shall be in a sealed envelope marked **RFP 21-032** containing (1) paper -based original, one (1) paper-based copy of the Proposal and one (1) digital format and DVD-ROM or Flash Drive media. All digital documents must be in searchable pdf format with each section of the proposal being its own file and submitted to the PSS Procurement Office no later than **May 26, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.** Any proposals received after the aforementioned date and time will not be accepted under any circumstances.
