Head Start / Early Head Start - Child Care Partnership Program

The CNMI PSS Head Start/Early Head Start - Child Care Partnership Program is a center-based comprehensive Birth to Five (5) program. Its policies and regulations meet the Head Start Program Performance Standards and requirements set forth by the Head Start Act of 2007. As required in Part §1302 - Program Operations, Subpart A - Eligibility, Recruitment, Selection, Enrollment, and Attendance, 1302.15 Enrollment of the performance standards, when an enrollment vacancy occurs, the slot is filled within 30 days. Head Start maintains its funded enrollment of 396. Early Head Start maintains its funded enrollment of 64. The CNMI Public School System directly operates 48 out of the 64 of the EHS enrollment, while the program's child care partner site operates the 16 out of 64.

In the school year 2015-16, the Chalan Kanoa and Dandan centers were opened; the Kagman and Tanapag centers were opened in the school year 2016-17, and the Susupe center was opened late of last school year 17-18.
